



### Instructions for Seesaw setup:

Parents and children are asked to set up their accounts by **March 29<sup>th</sup>** so that we are ready for work on **Monday 30<sup>th</sup>**.


1. Download Seesaw app or go to seesaw online/on computer.
2. Click "login" and then "I'm a student".
3. Type in "TEXT CODE" and click "GO".




4. This is your TEXT CODE:
5. Fill in details:





6. Click "Create account".
7. You should see something like this...



8. To add your work to your 'journal' or the 'class journal' just click the green plus sign and then whatever you would like to upload... for example, take a photo of your work (or video or whatever you wish. Experiment! It's good fun)!



9. Hit the green tick in the top right hand corner to upload.



10. At the moment, the children can only see their own work and not the work of others. For future group collaborations, I will change the settings so that they can see each other's contributions.
