For June, I am continuing to prescribe just 2 school activities each day and then I would like you to go out and enjoy the sunshine and help out at home!

Thanks for all your messages and pictures. Again feel free to use below as a menu- pick and choose as you see fit for your child and home circumstances.

### **Monday**

**English** – Read Unit 20 p80, see spellings. Do Activity A orally and B, C and D in the book.

**Maths** – Planet Maths p 150 and p151 A

As revision ask your child to draw out the coins that make up 35c, 80c, €1.20, €2.45, €3.10 and so on. This will show you how your child is at money. A lot of children find it difficult. I also advise you to bring out actual coins if your child is anyway hesitant. Take your time at this.

### **Tuesday**

**Geography-** Read Chapter 10 p 53 and do Activity A and B p 56.

**Irish** – See reading below and see words from next chapter of Ceart Litríú for spellings and general revision.

## Wednesday

**Maths-** p152. I advise to slow down doing this page. You will need to write out the sums on C. For the take aways, put decimal point under decimal point if using euro. *(Don't be overly concerned if you find this challenging I will make a note for 3<sup>rd</sup> class teacher).*

**English** – Re read p80 and do p82 and p83.

## Thursday

**Maths** – Planet Maths – p153 A and B – again take your time, you will definitely need to do these sums with your child.

**English** – Read Unit 21 –Heidi. Do p85 orally. P86 is more like a puzzle than real work! And p 87 is very good revision. – Leave one of these activities for Friday if you want.

## Friday

**Maths** – Have a go p154- Try your best with D, the rest of the page should be ok. Again, I advise not to rush and sit with your child when completing them.

**PE** – Have a sports day at home- don't forget spud and spoon race, three legged race, backwards race, crawling race, sack race, frog jump race. Have fun – get your siblings involved too!! – I think the good weather is coming back for weekend!
