

Dear Parent/Guardian,

As we approach the end of term, the following information may prove useful;

- There will be **no homework** for the remaining days of the term.
- Our return to school date for after the summer holidays is **Thurs August 26<sup>th</sup>**
- Booklists will be published in the next few days and we will take orders then from those who wish to purchase through the school. Bags will be distributed in late August similar to last year.
- **End of Year Reports** will be sent out this week. As this year and the previous school year have been anything but “standard” the Standardised Tests (2<sup>nd</sup> class to 6<sup>th</sup>) this term have been completed on an informal basis to help us identify if a child might need some extra help next year. Scores are not included on the Report Cards as the scoring system for the tests does not allow for the lockdown school closure periods. As always, if you have any concerns or wish to discuss any element of the Report Card an arrangement can be made to have a phone call with the teacher.
- Children are to continue to wear uniform up to and including this Thurs June 10<sup>th</sup>. **Fri June 11<sup>th</sup> is “Wear it Wacky Friday”** as a Parent Association Fundraiser. Due to the unusual year we have had with closures etc, the association has not looked for the normal voluntary contribution. There was a great response to a similar non uniform day before Christmas and your generosity would be appreciated again on this occasion. “Wear it Wacky” day is non uniform and children can be as creative as they like-ideas such as wearing odd colours/odd shoes/inside out/ upside-down/back to front/etc, etc. **All the final week, from June 14<sup>th</sup> to 18<sup>th</sup> is to be non uniform.**
