Grammes is the unit when measuring small items.

Kilogramme = Unit of Measurement for heavier items

$$1 \text{ kilo} = 1000 \text{ grammes} = 1.0\text{kg.}$$

$$\frac{1}{2} \text{ kilo} = 500\text{grammes} = 0.5\text{kg}$$

$$\frac{1}{4}\text{kilo} = 250\text{gramms} = 0.25\text{kg}$$

$$\frac{3}{4}\text{kilo} = 750\text{grammes} = 0.75\text{kg}$$

$$\frac{1}{10} = 100\text{grammes} = 0.1 \text{ kg}$$

$$\frac{2}{10} = \frac{1}{5} = 200\text{grammes} = 0.2\text{kg.}$$

$$\frac{3}{10} = 300\text{grammes} = 0.3\text{kg.}$$

$$\frac{4}{10} = \frac{2}{5} = 400\text{grammes} = 0.4\text{kg}$$
